Hamilton Fever strikes the library! On Tuesday, October 3<sup>rd</sup> beginning at 1:30 p.m., Richard Feingold will present *Alexander Hamilton – The Musical and the Duel*. A **Tuesday Talks for Seniors** event, this free program is sponsored by the Friends of the Library. Residents of all communities are invited to attend. Registration is now underway.

On Thursday, October 19<sup>th</sup>, the Friends of the Library in conjunction with the Library Board of Trustees will host a trip to see the hit Broadway show, **A Bronx Tale**. A musical based on the real life story of Chazz Palminteri, *A Bronx Tale* takes you to the stoops of the Bronx in the 1960s, where a young man is caught between the father he loves and the mob boss he'd love to be. Critics have called it a combination of *West Side Story* and *Jersey Boys*. A Wagner Tour Coach will depart from the North Haledon Municipal Parking Lot at 5 p.m. Seats are located in the center section of the mezzanine. Cost is \$125.00 for members of Friends and \$130.00 for the general public. Registration, which is now underway at the library, is open to residents of all communities. Payment in full is required to reserve a seat.
