Registration for the following programs and activities is now underway.

On Tuesday, August 1st at 1:30 p.m., Phil Jaeger will present *Castles of New Jersey*. Although not as numerous or grand as their European counterparts, a surprisingly large number of castles were built in New Jersey a century or more ago. Jaeger will take you on a PowerPoint tour of well-known castles such as Lambert and Kip's castles, as well as lesser known ones throughout the state. Many of them still exist, but others have vanished completely. A **Tuesday Talks for Seniors** presentation, this program is sponsored by the Friends of the Library.

Due to the overwhelming popularity of the May 2017 **Walk 'n' Talk** trip to Ellis Island the Statue of Liberty, the trip will be repeated on Wednesday, August 16th. A 14-passenger transit van will pick us up at the library at 8:00 a.m. and drop us off at Liberty State Park. We will board the ferry for Ellis Island where Mario Medici will treat us to a guided tour of Registry Hall. Following the tour, we'll break for lunch and then board the ferry to Liberty Island. We'll spend some time on Liberty Island visiting the Statue of Liberty and then board the ferry for the trip back to Liberty State Park, where our van will be waiting. We should arrive back in North Haledon by 5:00 p.m. Cost per person, which is \$55 for members of Friends of the Library and \$60 for the general public, covers transportation, ferry and admission ticket. Lunch is on your own. Payment in full is required to reserve a seat. Walk 'n' Talk is co-hosted by the Friends and the Library Board of Trustees.

La La Land will be shown on Tuesday, August 22nd at 1:30 p.m. Emma Stone and Ryan Gosling star as Mia and Sebastian, an actress and a jazz musician pursuing their Hollywood dreams – and finding each other – in a vibrant celebration of hope, dreams and love. Winner of six Academy Awards and seven Golden Globe Awards, *La La Land* is rated PG-13 and runs 128 minutes. A **Movies Worth Watching** presentation, this event is sponsored by the Friends. Seating is limited, so early registration is advised.

Ed Malec, author, teacher and world traveler, will present *A Quirky Guide to Joy* on Tuesday, September 5th beginning at 1:30 p.m. Based on his book of the same title, Malec's upbeat PowerPoint talk will focus on the many and varied joys life offers each of us.
