Registration for the following programs and activities is now underway.

The **Readers Kaffeeklatsch** book club will meet on Tuesday, July 11th at 1:30 p.m. to discuss *Rules of Civility* by Amor Towles. June Westlin will lead the discussion. New members are always welcome!

Crafty Ladies are invited to make air fresheners with Miss Ro on Tuesday, July 18th at 1:30 p.m. All supplies will be provided. Early registration is recommended!

Join Miss Susan for a trip to Roosevelt Island on Wednesday, July 19th. We'll assemble at the library at 9:00 a.m. and then board a 14-passenger transit van. Our adventure will start with a ride above the East River on the Roosevelt Island Tram. Once on the island, we'll make a brief stop at the Visitor Center & Gift Shop and then begin our **Walk 'n' Talk** with Mario Medici, licensed NYC tour guide, leading the way. We'll break for lunch at about 12:30 p.m. After lunch, we'll continue our tour until approximately 2:15 p.m. at which time we'll head back to the tram and our van. We should arrive back in North Haledon by 4:30 p.m. Mario estimates the total walking distance will be about 3 miles, all outdoors – so be sure to wear comfortable shoes, bring a hat and sunblock. Water and a snack will be provided. Cost per person, which is \$50.00 for the general public and \$45.00 for members of Friends, covers the van, the tram and a tip for the driver. Lunch is on your own. Payment is required to hold your reservation. The Walk 'n' Talk series is conducted under the auspices of the Library Board of Trustees and the Friends of the Library.

Lion will be shown on Tuesday, July 25th at 1:30 p.m. After getting lost on the streets of Calcutta as a five year-old, thirty year-old Saroo sets out to find his lost family. Based on the novel *A Long Way Home* by Saroo Brierley, this film is rated PG-13 and runs 118 minutes. A **Movies Worth Watching** presentation, this event is sponsored by the Friends. Seating is limited, so early registration is advised.

On Tuesday, August 1st Phil Jaeger will return to present *Castles of New Jersey*. Although not as numerous or grand as their European counterparts, a surprisingly large number of castles were built in New Jersey a century or more ago. Jaeger will take you on a PowerPoint tour of well-known castles such as Lambert and Kip's castles, as well as lesser known ones throughout the state. Many of them still exist, but others have vanished completely. A **Tuesday Talks for Seniors** presentation, this program is sponsored by the Friends of the Library.
