Registration for the following programs and activities is now underway.

Lost Amusement Parks of the North Jersey Shore will be the topic of a PowerPoint presentation by Rick Geffken on Tuesday, May 1st starting at 1:30 p.m. From the time of the Native Americans, the Jersey Shore has attracted people seeking relief from summer heat and humidity. By the end of the 19th century, the 120 mile-long coastline was dotted with amusement parks featuring kiddie rides, roller coasters, merry-go-rounds, and fast-food emporiums. Geffken will share rarely seen images of what was once the most famous vacation and recreational destination in the coastal United States. Copies of his book will be available for purchase. Join Miss Susan for a walking tour featuring the Brooklyn Bridge and the D.U.M.B.O. area of Brooklyn on Wednesday, May 16th. We'll meet at the library at 9:00 a.m. and board a transit van for the ride into the City. Mario Medici, licensed NYC Tour Guide, will provide commentary as we **Walk 'n' Talk** our way over the Brooklyn Bridge, through the D.U.M.B.O. (Down Under the Manhattan Bridge Overpass) area of Brooklyn and along the Brooklyn Park Promenade. We'll take the ferry back to Manhattan where our van will be waiting. We should arrive home by 4:30 p.m. Cost per person, which is \$50 for the general public, and \$45.00 for members of Friends, covers the van, ferry ride, and driver's tip. Lunch is on your own. We will be walking 3-4 miles, so comfortable shoes are highly recommended. Payment in full is required to reserve a seat. Walk 'n' Talk is co-hosted by the Friends and the Library Board of Trustees.

Megan Leavey will be shown on Tuesday, May 22nd at 1:30 p.m. This drama is based on the true life story of a young Marine Corporal (Kate Mara) whose unique discipline and bond with her military combat dog saved many lives during their deployment in Iraq. The film runs 116 minutes and is rated PG-13. A **Movies Worth Watching** presentation, this event is sponsored by the Friends.
