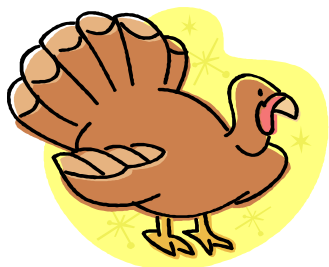


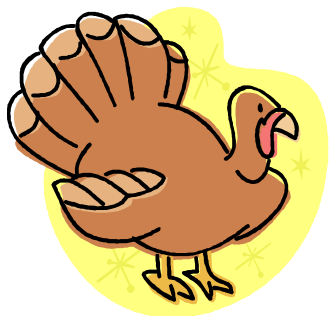

November 2017



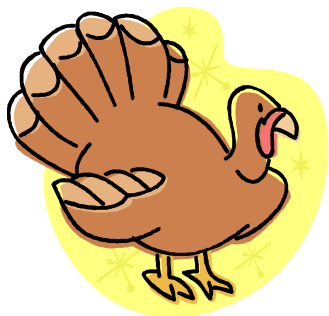
Registration for the following programs for adults is now underway.

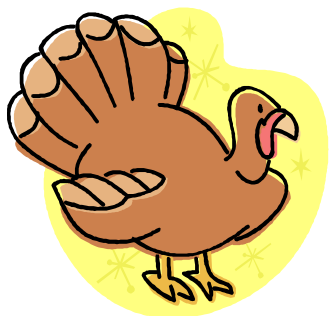
The Library will be closed on Saturday, November 11th in observance of Veterans Day.

The Friends of the Library Executive Board will meet at the library on Tuesday, November 14th at 1:30 p.m. All members are welcome to attend.

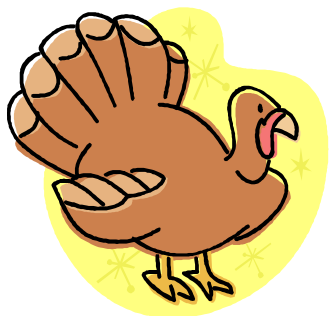

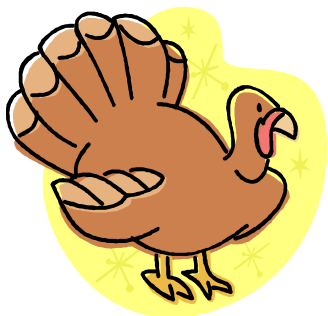
UPCOMING CHILDREN'S PROGRAMS & ACTIVITIES
