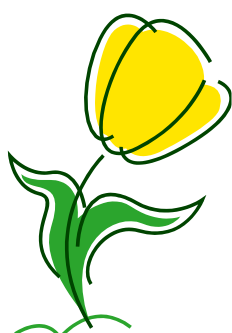

Residents of all communities are invited to join nature writer and photographer Jim Wright for a presentation on *The Birds in Our Backyards* at 1:30 p.m. on Tuesday, April 2nd. Jim will talk about his favorite avian neighbors – including spring arrivals and departures, as well as year-round residents – and how to attract them. He'll also offer some bird-feeding dos and don'ts, and explain why. As a bonus, he will talk about the Bald Eagles about to hatch two eggs at Duke Farms in Central New Jersey – plus how you can now watch the nesting eagles any time of day via a high-tech webcam. Jim is the author of several books on birds and nature. He is celebrating his 10th year writing the popular "Bird Watcher" column for The Record.
