Registration for the following programs and activities is now underway.

Join us on Tuesday, August 7th at 1:30 p.m. as Joey Gilligan presents *The Musical History of the 50s – from Dino to Doo Wop*. Singing professionally since the age of 13, “Joey G.” opened for many of the top acts of the time, including Bobby Rydell, the Drifters and The Earls. A **Tuesday Talks for Seniors** presentation, this program is sponsored by the Friends of the Library and is open to residents of all communities.

We’re heading back to the Brooklyn Bridge and the D.U.M.B.O. area of Brooklyn on Wednesday, August 22nd for an evening **Walk ‘n’ Talk** tour. We’ll meet at the library at 3:30 p.m. and board a 14-passenger transit van for the ride into New York. Our tour will begin with Mario Medici, licensed NYC Tour Guide, leading us across the iconic Brooklyn Bridge and providing commentary along the way. After crossing the bridge, we’ll head to the D.U.M.B.O. (Down Under the Manhattan Bridge Overpass) area of Brooklyn. After dinner at a local restaurant, we will walk along the water in Brooklyn Bridge Park and enjoy the view as the lights come on. The tour will conclude with a short ferry ride back to Manhattan where our van will be waiting. We should arrive home by 10:30 p.m. Cost per person, which is \$45.00 for members of Friends of the Library and \$50.00 for the general public, covers transportation, ferry, and driver’s tip. Dinner is on your own. Payment in full is required to reserve a seat. Walk ‘n’ Talk is co-hosted by the Library Board of Trustees and the Friends of the Library. Priority for registration will be given to members of Friends.
