This year's Service will feature two guest speakers: Congresswoman Mikie Sherrill and North Haledon resident, Richard S. Van Harken. Congresswoman Sherrill graduated the U.S. Naval Academy in 1994 and spent almost 10 years on active duty in the U.S. Navy. After leaving the Navy, she attended law school, earning a degree from Georgetown University. She worked as a lawyer and eventually joined the U.S. Attorney's Office in New Jersey. As an Assistant U.S. Attorney, Congresswoman Sherrill worked to keep our communities safe, prosecuting federal cases and advising law enforcement on investigations. She serves as Freshman Whip for the new Democratic Coalition and sits on the House Armed Services Committee and House Science, Space, and Technology Committee.

Richard S. Van Harken graduated Vanderbilt University in 1989 and following in the family tradition, went on to serve in the U.S. Army during the first Gulf War. His eldest son is currently deployed with the U.S. Army in a combat zone overseas.

The program will also include a presentation of colors by Boy Scout Troop #170 and the North Haledon Police Honor Guard, a tribute to deceased members of American Legion Post #428, placement of the ceremonial wreath, a rifle volley salute, bugle taps, and more. Musical accompaniment to the service will be provided by Deena Leff, Music for the Moment and Lucky Roberto-Desch. A light lunch will be served following the service.
