

North Haledon Playground Rules

→ Immediately before coming to the playground check you and your child's temperature and check for the following symptoms: Fever or chills Cough Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing Fatigue Muscle or body aches Headache New loss of taste or smell Sore throat Congestion or runny nose Nausea or vomiting Diarrhea Persistent pain or pressure in the chest New confusion Inability to wake or stay awake Pale, gray, or blue-colored skin, lips, or nail beds, depending on skin tone Discoloration, swelling or rash on their feet or toes (or hands and fingers). If you or your child have **any** of the preceding symptoms or you or their temperature is 100 or higher **do not** visit the playground.

→ Bring hand sanitizer to the playground for use before entering and for reapplication every 15 minutes. Please do your best to have your child avoid touching their eyes, nose, and mouth. Young children should be supervised in the use of hand sanitizer. We will try to have hand sanitizer at the playground but please bring your own in case it runs out.

→ Have you and your child stay 6 feet or more away from those who are not from the same household.

→ Come back to playground another time if it is difficult to social distance on the playground with the amount of people present.

→ Please cover coughs and sneezes with a disposable tissue or cough and sneeze into the elbow rather than hands. Please dispose of the tissue properly and sanitize you or your child's hands after coughing or sneezing.

→ Adults and children age two and older are required to wear cloth face coverings when visiting the playground when social distancing is not feasible. Also, even if social distancing is possible, we encourage you and your children to wear masks at all times. Please ensure that your child's cloth face coverings fits properly and take precautions to ensure that there are no hanging strings or loops that could catch on equipment.

→ While in the playground no chewing gum, eating candy or consuming of food or drinks are allowed. Also, no spitting is permitted.

→ If a member of your household or someone you or your child had close contact with (within 6 feet for more than 15 minutes) was diagnosed with COVID-19 in the last 14 days you may not use the playground.
